## The Visionary: Dr C.M. Singh



**Dr C.M. Singh** (1922-2005) was a great visionary and a man of action, always talked of “optimism in hopelessness” which he adapted as a principle of his life. He was more of an Institution than an individual. He is widely regarded as the “Doyen of Veterinary Profession in India”. Dr C.M. Singh was an eminent Veterinary Pathologist and Microbiologist, and has made outstanding contributions in etio-pathogenesis and diagnosis of animal diseases mainly listeriosis, salmonellosis, mycoplasmosis, bovine lymphosarcoma and slow viral respiratory diseases. There is a need that youngsters should know about his life, contributions and achievements for advancement of veterinary profession. Dr C.M. Singh Endowment Trust, Bareilly was established in 1999 to work with this mission and for welfare of veterinarians. The Trust organizes national conferences, memorial lectures, felicitates eminent veterinarians, institutes award for best veterinary science students, different competitions and publishes relevant literature. ## About Host Institute - ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal

National Institute of High Security Animal Diseases (NIHSAD) of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) is a premier institute of India for research on exotic and emerging pathogens of animals. During the early 1970s, the need for a special bio-containment facility for diagnostic preparedness for exotic/ emerging animal diseases in the country was conceptualized by great visionaries including Dr C. M. Singh. That led to the establishment of High Security Animal Disease Laboratory (HSADL) under Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar in 1998 and subsequently attained the status as a National Institute, ICAR-NIHSAD in 2014.

The institute has certified BSL3 bio-containment laboratory and an animal bio-containment facility for handling of high risk pathogens including zoonotic agents. Research programs of the institute include development of diagnostics and vaccines against exotic and emerging pathogens, host-pathogen interactions studies, risk analysis, molecular epidemiology etc. ICAR-NIHSAD also provides disease diagnostic services, and technical support to policy makers for control of exotic and emerging diseases. Presently, ICAR-NIHSAD offers diagnostic services for 22 exotic and emerging diseases of poultry and livestock. The avian influenza laboratory of NIHSAD was recognised as WOA (World Organisation for Animal Health, formerly OIE) reference laboratory in 2009. NIHSAD is also mandated for capacity building in bio-risk management.
