# **The Visionary Dr C.M. Singh**

Dr Chinta Mani Singh was born in a village in the Distt. Jaunpur (UP) on 30<sup>th</sup> November 1922. He was more of an Institution than an individual. People like-him take birth in this world only once in a century. He was a dreamer and a man of action, always talked of "optimism in hopelessness" which he adapted as a principle of his life. He was the "God Father of Indian Veterinary Profession". He was an eminent Veterinary Pathologist and Microbiologist and has made outstanding contributions in animal diseases. He was an excellent teacher and researcher and an able administrator and distinguished veterinary educationist. His vision and thoughtful plans converted post-independent IVRI of 5 Divisions into 21 Divisions of National Institute of International fame. He was the Founder President of Veterinary Council of India (VCI) and National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (NAVS). Dr C.M. Singh had collaboration and interaction with international agencies. Further, as a person, Dr Singh was humble, honest and hardworking. He was a great visionary.

## About Host Institute

Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (GADVASU) started functioning on April 21, 2006 at Ludhiana to serve the society by promoting livestock production, health and prevention of diseases through integrated teaching, research and extension programmes. There are six constituent colleges viz. College of Veterinary Science (Ludhiana and Rampura Phul Campus), College of Dairy Science and Technology, College of Fisheries, College of Animal Biotechnology and Veterinary Polytechnic College, Kaljharani along with three Regional Livestock Research & Training Centres and Krishi Vigyan Kendras. The University has two affiliated colleges (Khalsa College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Amritsar and Baba Hira Das Ji College of Veterinary Pharmacy, Badal, Sri Muktsar Sahib).

The University is accredited by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) 'A' grade, and recognized by the University Grant Commission (UGC). It is also a member of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), Indian Agricultural Universities Association (IAUA) and the National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (NAVS). The University boasts of three ICAR Centers of Advanced Faculty Training (CAFT) in Veterinary Surgery & Radiology, Veterinary Gynecology & Obstetrics and Veterinary Pathology. World Bank funded project on National Agricultural Higher Education Project, implemented by ICAR as Institutional Development Project is currently underway at the University. The University is consistently retaining top slots in ICAR rankings year after year.
