## The Visionary: Dr C.M. Singh



**Dr C.M. Singh** was more of an Institution than an individual. People like him take birth in this world only once in a century. He was a dreamer and a man of action, always talked of “optimism in hopelessness” which he adapted as a principle of his life. He was the “God Father of Veterinary Profession”. Dr C.M. Singh was an eminent Veterinary Pathologist and Microbiologist and has made outstanding contributions in etio-pathogenesis and diagnosis of animal diseases mainly listeriosis, salmonellosis, mycoplasmosis, bovine lymph sarcoma and slow viral respiratory diseases. # About Host Institute

The Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences carries the historical legacy of the century old Bengal Veterinary College. When India was under the British rule, the Bengal Veterinary College was established on 10<sup>th</sup> January, 1893 at Belgachia, Calcutta. It was the second Veterinary College of its kind in undivided India under the Government of Bengal. In 1974, a State Agricultural University was established in the name of Bidhan Chandra Krishi Viswavidyalay (BCKV) at Mohanpur, Nadia in accordance with newly introduced ICAR Agricultural Education System in the country; and the Bengal Veterinary College was officially shifted to this University, which was emerged as a Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences. As per recommendation of the Working Group, the Govt. of West Bengal, the West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences (WBUAFS) was established bifurcating the BCKV and emerged as the 2<sup>nd</sup> Veterinary University of its kind in India after TANUVAS. The Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, the largest faculty of this university, started functioning again at the erstwhile Bengal Veterinary College campus at Kolkata. The UG programme (BVSc & AH) is being offered at the Mohanpur Campus as per the Minimum Standards of Veterinary Education Regulations of the VCI. The MVSc and PhD programme has been continuing at the Belgachia campus. Recently from the Academic Session 2016-17 a Diploma in Veterinary Pharmacy course was also introduced under this Faculty at Mohanpur campus. The Faculty and its UG programme (BVSc & AH) are accredited by the VCI, New Delhi, and the Faculty with its UG, PG and PhD programmes are accredited by the ICAR, New Delhi.
