Dr C.M. Singh – Brief Profile

Dr C.M. Singh, “Doyen of Veterinary Profession” was born in a remote village in the Dist. Jaunpur (UP) on 30 November 1922. He obtained BVSc degree from Bihar Veterinary College, Patna and MS, PhD from MSU, East Lansing, USA. Dr C.M. Singh was an



eminent Veterinary Pathologist and Microbiologist and has made outstanding contributions in animal diseases mainly listeriosis, salmonellosis, mycoplasmosis, bovine lymphosarcoma and slow viral respiratory diseases. He was most dynamic Director, IVRI and founder President of VCI and NAVS(I).

Dr C.M. Singh Endowment Trust was established with Dr Singh's directive, blessings and financial support in 1999 with objectives of advancement of veterinary science and welfare of livestock, farmers and veterinarians of this country. Trust organizes national conferences, memorial lectures, felicitates eminent veterinarians, institutes award for best veterinary science students, different competitions and publishes relevant literature. 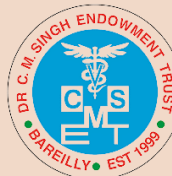
