## The Visionary: Dr C.M. Singh



**Dr C.M. Singh** (1922-2005) was more of an Institution than an individual. People like him take birth in this world only once in a century. He was a dreamer and a man of action, always talked of “optimism in hopelessness” which he adapted as a principle of his life. He was the “God Father of Veterinary Profession”. Dr C.M. Singh was an eminent Veterinary Pathologist and Microbiologist and has made outstanding contributions in etio-pathogenesis and diagnosis of animal diseases mainly listeriosis, salmonellosis, mycoplasmosis, bovine lymphosarcoma and slow viral respiratory diseases. There is a need that youngsters should know about his life, contributions and achievements for advancement of veterinary profession. Dr. C.M. Singh Endowment Trust, Bareilly (cmset.org) works with this mission and for welfare of veterinarians.

## About Host Institute-TANUVAS

The first Veterinary and Animal Sciences University in Asia was established on 20th September 1989 with its headquarters in Chennai with the name Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (popularly abbreviated as TANUVAS) after realizing the importance of education and research in animal and fisheries so as to increase its productivity towards better income generation for the farmers. TANUVAS has been conferred with the prestigious “Sardar Patel Outstanding ICAR Institution Award, 2011”, recognizing its outstanding performance in education, research, and extension in the country in the field of agricultural sciences including Veterinary and Animal Sciences. Recently, TANUVAS has been ranked first among the 15 State Veterinary Universities in India by the ICAR (2020) ranking and secured 12th place on the list of agriculture, veterinary, horticulture and fisheries universities across the country.

## Madras Veterinary College, Chennai

The Madras Veterinary College (MVC), the first of the four constituent Veterinary Colleges of TANUVAS, was started as an equine treatment school with five students in a temporary structure at Saidapet, Chennai in 1903. It was the first institution to be recognized for offering undergraduate programme in Veterinary Science under University of Madras as early as 1936 and was one of the first institutions to start MVSc and PhD programmes in many subjects of veterinary sciences and this institution was the seed for the formation of first Veterinary University in India. It is also the first veterinary institution in the country to send its graduates to overseas universities like-Michigan State University, East Lansing, USA and Virginia-Maryland Regional College of Veterinary Medicine for doing part of their internship and also to accept students from overseas universities for externship.
