The Visionary: Dr C.M. Singh



Dr C.M. Singh was more of an Institution than an individual. People like him take birth in this world only once in a century. He was a dreamer and a man of action, always talked of “optimism in hopelessness” which he adapted as a principle of his life. He was the “God Father of Veterinary Profession”. Dr C.M. Singh was an eminent Veterinary Pathologist and Microbiologist and has made outstanding contributions in etio-pathogenesis and diagnosis of animal diseases mainly listeriosis, salmonellosis, mycoplasmosis, bovine lymphosarcoma and slow viral respiratory diseases. There is a need that youngsters should know about his life, contributions and achievements for advancement of veterinary profession. Dr C.M. About Host Institute-KVAFSU

The Government of Karnataka took bold steps in establishing the Karnataka Veterinary, Animal and Fisheries Sciences University (KVAFSU) on the floor of the Legislative Assembly. The KVAFSU was formed as per the Karnataka Act No. 9 of 2004 namely The Karnataka Veterinary, Animal and Fisheries University Act 2004 and published in the Karnataka Gazette Extra-Ordinary on the 23rd day of February, 2004. The University was established exclusively for the development of education and learning; conduct of research and extension education and transfer the rural oriented technologies in the areas of Veterinary, Animal, Dairy and Fisheries Sciences in Karnataka. The logo of the University is inscribed with the slogan 'Farmers Friendly and Rural Oriented', which emphasizes the importance given to betterment of farming community. Prof. R.N. Sreenivas Gowda was appointed as its first Vice Chancellor and served with effect from September, 2004 until February 2008. Prof. Suresh Honnappagol served as second Vice Chancellor of the University. KVAFSU is an autonomous academic institution governed by its Board of Management which regulates the policies of the university in accordance with the provision of act and statues. The University administration also has the support of the finance Committee. Academic matters are looked after by the Board of Studies of Faculties and the Academic Council, while Research Council and Extension Education Council decide the research and extension activities of the University, respectively.

Veterinary College, Bengaluru

It was inaugurated on 25th July, 1958, by the then Chief Minister of Karnataka Shri B.D. Jatti and started functioning in Mysore Serum Institute, now called Institute of Animal Health and Veterinary Biologicals. The present college campus, located in the 196 acres plot was inaugurated by Shri Jaya Chamarajendra Wodeyar, the then Governor of Karnataka, on 6th January 1962 and the same was then affiliated to Mysore University, Mysore. In 1965, the college became the constituent college of the University of Agricultural Sciences, Bangalore under trimester system of education in-line with land-grant system of education. In 2004, after the establishment of Karnataka Veterinary, Animal and Fisheries Sciences University, the college has become the part of the Veterinary University

The College celebrated its golden jubilee year from September 2007 to August 2008. The main focus of this college is teaching, research and extension. Its aim is to make veterinary education responsive to the growing needs of the society in general and aspirations of the livestock farmers in particular. To meet the challenges, the college has nineteen well equipped departments with highly qualified and skilled staff involved in offering BVSc&AH programme as per Veterinary Council of India regulations. The college is also involved in offering Masters and Doctoral program in seventeen and fourteen disciplines respectively. The college has instructional farm that includes dairy, sheep, piggery, poultry farm and experimental small animal unit. The college has so far produced about 4,000 veterinary graduates and more than 1,200 post graduates who are working across the globe in different capacities.
