## **The Visionary: Dr C. M. Singh**

The visionary Dr C.M. Singh; is considered as "Doyen of Veterinary Profession", "God Father", "Bhishmpitamah","Purushottam", "Karamyogi" and "Preranashrot". He started his glorious career from Veterinary College, Mathura in 1960s and shaped veterinary research and education of India. He was an eminent Veterinary Pathologist and Microbiologist and has made outstanding contributions in etiopathogenesis and diagnosis of animal and poultry diseases. He was instrumental in the creation of the Veterinary Council of India and the National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (India).

## **The Trust**

Dr C. M. Singh Endowment Trust, Bareilly ([cmset.org](http://cmset.org)) was founded in year 1999 with blessings and vision of Dr C. M. Singh. Since then, the Trust is working on his principles for the cause of Veterinary Profession. Frequently, the Trust organizes National Seminars, World Veterinary Day, Dr C. M. Singh Memorial Lectures, felicitates veterinarians etc., in different institutions of the country. The 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 is Birth Centenary Day of late Dr Singh. To mark this historic occasion, the Trust is celebrating Dr C. M. Singh Birth Centenary Year from 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021 to 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 in association with the Veterinary Institutions of Country. Throughout the year, the Trust is organizing webinars on specific burning subjects on 30<sup>th</sup> Day of every month at different Veterinary Institutions in various regions of country. To celebrate the World Veterinary Day; the Trust has decided to collaborate with the Nagpur Veterinary College; a constituent College under Maharashtra Animal & Fishery Sciences University (MAFSU), Nagpur with the theme "**Strengthening Veterinary Resilience**".

## **About the College**

Nagpur Veterinary College was established on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 1958 with only three Departments viz. Anatomy, Physiology and Animal Husbandry under the administrative control of the Government of Maharashtra with affiliation to the Nagpur University. Subsequently, the College was brought under the administrative control of the then Dr Punjabrao Deshmukh Krishi Vidyapeeth, Akola. Finally, with the establishment of Maharashtra Animal & Fishery Sciences University at Nagpur in the year 2000, the institute became a constituent college of the University. The graduate courses BVSc & AH of five years duration as per the VCI minimum standards of education regulations is being offered along with the postgraduate and doctoral programs in most of the disciplines as per the ICAR norms. The institute is implementing various research projects funded by ICMR, DST, DBT, ICAR and also by the State Government under RKVY. The College is catering to the demand of trained human resource in the State and also training the field veterinarians and veterinary graduates in advanced areas. The institute is enormously contributing to the society through research on 'One Health'. The 'Centre for Zoonoses' is 'State of the Art' Facility for zoonotic diseases which has also contributed as first veterinary team in India to address human pandemic by screening samples for COVID-19.

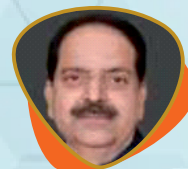
